

Dr Inam ur Rahman, a model teacher, an institutional builder, a great human being, born in 1937. He did MSc (Physics) from Government College Lahore and joined Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission in the year 1959. He earned MS in Nuclear Engineering from MIT, USA in 1962 and on his return started a training program for young scientists and engineers of the commission. After completion of PhD from North Carolina State University, USA in 1969 he took charge of the Reactor School. The school was renamed as Center for Nuclear Studies (CNS) in 1976 and moved to the current location from PINSTECH in 1978, renamed again as Pakistan Institute of Engineering and Applied Sciences (PIEAS) in 1997, got degree awarding charter in 2000.

Dr. Inam ur Rahman relinquished the administrative responsibilities in 1997 at the time of superannuation but never left the institution which he built from a single room Reactor School to the best engineering university of Pakistan, PIEAS, and formed the dedicated scientific and technological leadership for the country.
